



ESTIMATED 600K UNDOCUMENTED MIGRANTS THIRD-COUNTRY NATIONALS

Safety of people and public health are a priority

Restrictive measures paralyzed entire economic sectors where migrant workers, EU and non EU nationals, were occupied

Estimated 350K seasonal workers missing, mostly farm workers from other European countries

Agriculture and Domestic work: high numbers of undeclared work, labour exploitation and undocumented migrants

2018 restrictions on humanitarian permits increased the number of undocumented migrants

Until 1998, lack of specific policies to attract migrant workers, to tackle international human-trafficking, to contrast labour exploitation

In 1998, 2002 and 2018, introduced quotas available for migrant workers, job-seeker visa cancelled, increased sanctioncs for illegal immigration, tourism and other visas not valid to obtain a work-related residence permit, strict conditions to release a permit for humanitarian purposes


Reduction of quotas available for migrant workers


Due to the national economic situation (2007-present) and the refugee crisis (2015 - 2017), drastic reduction of visa released for working purposes. In 2020 released 30k quotas vs. 150k in 2007


Expulsions are complicated and expensive

Low percentage of repatriated irregular migrants, need to renovate and strenghten agreements with origin countries
